Daniel Gorczyk, Dan as he was known to his family and friends, was a normal 16 year old boy attending school and playing varsity sports at Scranton Prep. One August afternoon in 2003, Dan collapsed suddenly on the practice football field and tragically passed away the next day. Dan had an unknown and little heard of ailment known as Long QT Syndrome (LQTS), an electrical malfunction of the heart. LQTS causes sudden fibrillation of the heart muscle, leaving its victims dizzy or faint and in extreme cases, causing sudden death.

The Board of Directors of the Daniel J. Gorczyk Memorial Golf Tournament invites you to participate in this outing to help us raise awareness of LQT Syndrome and raise funds to aid other families facing the tragic loss of a beloved child, caused by this disease.
